There is still time for CPs who have not submitted their AIT issues for the Review to do so.

When the new AIT (Artificial Inflation of Traffic) process was launched in March 2010, one of the provisions was that there should be the opportunity for a contract review of AIT after twelve months.

Further to Interconnect Briefing 009-11 we have currently received two replies to our request to submit any review issues.

There is still an opportunity for CPs who have not submitted their issues to do so by close of play Friday 25 March 2011

Can CPs submit any review issues that they may have to BT to commercial.interface@bt.com with "2011 AIT Contract Review" in the subject line.

A pro-forma is appended as a Related File which it would be helpful to use.

If any CP wishes to pursue issues bilaterally – i.e. not as part of a common industry process - a CP is of course at liberty to do that. If a CP wishes to submit information which it does not wish to be shared with the generality of CPs, then the CP needs to clearly mark it as "Sensitive" or "Confidential" and BTW will not include the information in the Consolidated issues Document.
