## BT Wholesale - Invitation to AIT Contract Review Meeting

When the new AIT (Artificial Inflation of Traffic) process was launched in March 2010, one of the provisions was that there should be the opportunity for a contract review of AIT after twelve months.

In accordance with the "SIA Contract Review Guideline" Step 1 - BT invited CPs to submit any review issues to BT by close of play Friday 4th March 2011 to the BT Commercial Interface Team, Step 2 required CPs to submit their views and this briefing is being issued in line with Step 3 to produce and publish the consolidated list of issues on the BT Wholesale website and invite CPs to a 1st meeting to discuss.

BT originally planned to hold the meeting earlier during March but in light of the limited response level to the original briefing, BT decided to remind the industry of the opportunity to submit issues and the issues list was updated following this exercise.

BT is proposing an initial meeting with the parties who have engaged in May to clarify issues and classify them (Step 3), with the intention of also agreeing the ongoing discussion programme and target timescales. Invitations will be issued accordingly.
